Selection Process for Applicants

Applicants selected for the program will be notified by mail and their Sheridan email account. These decisions may not be released over the phone. Fee, registration and timetable information will follow. Classes for the fall term begin Tuesday, September 4, 2012.

Instructions for Applicants

Submit a portfolio. Additional details will be provided to applicants to the program.

Format:

- Include 8.5" x 11" colour or black and white photocopies of original work in either landscape or portrait orientation (portfolio will not be returned). Electronic submissions (ie. CDs, DVDs, etc.) will not be accepted. Assemble your submission in a flat 2-dimensional portfolio/folder/report cover. Mail in a 9" X 12" envelope.

Content:

- Letter of intent to include
 - o Why Interior Design
 - o Why Sheridan
 - o Why You
- Include 10 photocopies of your original work that demonstrates your ability to be creative. This may include (but is not limited to):
 - o Drawings
 - o Paintings
 - o Design work
 - o Sculpture
 - o Photography
 - o Architectural drawings
 - o AutoCAD drawings
 - o or anything you feel may support your application for Interior Design

- Provide a description of each image included in your portfolio (ie. date, medium, concept etc.)
- Include the following on the back of each photocopy:
 - o Student number
 - o Full Name
 - o Address
 - o Telephone number
- Enclose a certified cheque or money order for \$50 payable to Sheridan College Institute of Technology and Advanced Learning for the assessment of the portfolio.
